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Salmon Camp Personal Gear

Personal comfort while in the field is important. The type and how much of fabric you wear are important. To do this you need to balance warmth, water resistance, comfort and weight. Bringing the correct gear not only makes you more comfortable but will allow you to get more field work done. Below is the minimal suggested gear and clothing you should bring. However, bringing more stuff can also be a problem as what you bring you may have to tote so pack lightly and smartly. There is a weight limit on the plane, so everyone's gear will be checked and any excess stuff will be left and stored in Dillingham.

Good rain gear is essential. The weather each day can't be predicted but one thing we can depend on is that we will work in wet, windy conditions. Clothes such as fleece, wool, and polypropylene are recommended because they can keep you warm when wet and dry quickly. Layering different fabric types will help you to adjust to the changing weather or to the variety of exercise while working. Cotton fabrics (clothes and sleeping bags) should not be used as they take a long time to dry and when wet they will draw heat away from your body.

Carrying a small backpack with a rain suit, extra socks, water and light snacks is recommended. In your pack, all gear should be in waterproof bags. Bring extra bags to protect small items such as cameras, journals, or books (heavy duty 'Ziploc' style bags work well).

Showering will be a luxury. However, you will want to remain clean so to bathe you will be taking lots of birdbaths so have your favorite washcloth and soap handy.
