The Salmon Camp Education Director will report to the Education, Employment & Training Director and develop, plan and implement three separate hands-on field-based learning experiences for 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students from around the Bristol Bay region.

### **Camp Purpose:**

Salmon Camp students are immersed in hands-on, true-to-life scientific inquiries in ichthyology, entomology, limnology, and environmental science. Days are spent collecting data in the field while evenings are spent analyzing data. BBEDC promotes fisheries research and management as a potential field of study and future employment through participation in Salmon Camp.

### **Qualifications:**

- Alaska Certified Teacher with biology or other natural science endorsements;
- Ability to operate small boat and outboard motor;
- Excel at quickly developing positive student report;
- Able to effectively communicate with students from various communities around the Bristol Bay region;
- Familiarity with Bristol Bay salmon biology and management;
- Experience with various field techniques common to salmon research;
- Physically able to work outdoors in inclement weather;
- 1<sup>st</sup> Aid/CPR desired;
- Pass the background check and drug screening to the satisfaction of BBEDC.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Assist in selection of students attending camp;
- Assist in creation of camp schedule and coordination of camp logistics;
- Review and update camp curriculum;
- Supervise students attending camp;
- Operate small boat and outboard motor around Lake Aleknagik;
- Coordinate logistics and instruction with participating agencies;
- Lead instruction both in a field and classroom setting.
