- Alaska drivers license and clean driving record
- Bilingual in English and Yupik

### Duties

- Assist the coordinator in planning for, organizing and facilitating activities
- Recruit teens and young adults to participate in programs
- Collect and organizing drift wood
- Set, check, and tend to the subsistence net
- Processing the subsistence catch in traditional ways
- Assist with upkeep of processing facilities and equipment including the smokehouse, cutting tables, and vacuum sealer
- Other duties as assigned
