Qualifications

- A BBEDC CDQ community resident
- Must be 14-17 years old
- Personal & professional commitment to prevent/eliminate power based interpersonal violence and to empower youth to take active leadership roles in shaping their lives and community in which they reside
- Ability to work with young people from various social/ethnic/cultural backgrounds
- Ability to give and receive oral and written communication
- Ability to cope with stress and crisis situations in a calm manner
- Willingness & ability to constructively confront issues of gender and race
- Must be free from substance abuse & model non-violent behavior
- Confidentiality is a must

Duties

- Facilitate and co-facilitate activities for children and teens age 5-19
- Assist the coordinator in planning, organizing, and facilitating games nights, dances, support groups and other youth led/youth involved activities
- Recruit teens and young adults to participate in program events
- Support a core group of trained teen volunteers for events
- Design/distribute flyers and notices to advertise program functions
- Arrange/provide group support services including food and reserving space
- Identify issues, assess the needs and engage with youth in developing leadership skills and strategies to resolve identified issues
- Perform other duties as assigned

Compensation

- \$15.00 per hour
- 40 hours per week
- May - July 2021
- Up to 10 weeks of employment
