Qualifications

- Must be a resident of a BBEDC CDQ Community
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Alaska Driver's License
- Knowledge of community safety issues
- Familiar with UTVs equipment, buildings, and vehicles
- Able to write effectively and have good communication skills
- Random drug testing may be conducted at any time
- Pass a State of Alaska Police Report for current license and clean driving record

Duties

- Maintain personal time log and time card
- Operate and maintain the village landfill
- Collect and properly dispose of hazardous wastes
- Separate burnable waste before placing in landfill
- Provide community landfill outreach
- Proper utilization of village vehicles and equipment for work
- Maintenance of village vehicles and equipment as required/requested
- Fire safety - cut brush and grass to prevent fires during summer months
- Other duties as assigned

Compensation

- \$25.00 per hour *
- 40 hours per week
- June - September 2021
- up to 16 weeks of employment
