QUALIFICATIONS:

- MUST BE A BBEDC CDQ COMMUNITY RESIDENT
- MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD
- HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED REQUIRED
- VALID ALASKA DRIVERS LICENSE
- NO FELONY OR DISQUALIFYING CRIMINAL HISTORY
- MUST DEMONSTRATE EXCELLENT PHYSICAL HEALTH - ABLE TO LIFT UP TO 50 POUNDS AND OCCASIONALLY LIFT AND/OR MOVE MORE THAN 100LBS
- MUST PASS A PRE-EMPLOYMENT DRUG SCREEN
- ABLE TO PASS VISION REQUIREMENTS TEST
- POSSESS OR OBTAIN ALASKA EMT OR NATIONAL EMT CERTIFICATE

DUTIES:

- RESPOND TO FIRE, RESCUE, HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, AND OTHER EMERGENCIES AS ASSIGNED BY EMS/FIRE DEPARTMENT COORDINATOR
- PERFORM AS AN EMT AND ACT AS LEAD CREW MEMBER WHEN NEEDED
- OPERATE RESCUE EQUIPMENT
- ASSIST IN CLEANING AMBULANCE AND OR FIRE EQUIPMENT AS NEEDED
- ENSURE AMBULANCE REPORTS ARE ACCURATE AND RETURNED TO THE EMS/FIRE DEPARTMENT COORDINATOR WITHIN 24 HOURS
- RESTOCK ANY AND ALL SUPPLIES USED ON AN AMBULANCE CALL
- OTHER DUTIES AS ASSIGNED

- JUNE - SEPTEMBER 2021
- UP TO 16 WEEKS OF EMPLOYMENT
